# SHREWSBURY HOUSE SEVENS

## RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- 1 a) All boys must be Under 13 for the Senior Competition or Under 11 for the Junior Competition on midnight of 31 August 2009.  
b) A strict weight limit will be enforced for both competitions: 10 stone (63.kgs) for Under 13's and 8 stone (50.8kgs) for the Under 11's.
- 2 A size 4 ball will be used for the Under 13's and a size 4 ball for the Under 11's.
- 3 A squad may consist of a maximum of 10 players.
- 4 In the event of a clash of colours, the first named team are expected to change or at the discretion of the referee.
- 5 The Preliminary round of group matches will be 5 minutes each way, with 1 minute at half-time. At the knock out stage the matches are also 5 minutes each way.

## IN THE EVENT OF A DRAW

The groups will be decided on a Win, Draw, Loss basis and this year will include a bonus point system:

	<b>POINTS</b>
WIN	4
DRAW	2
LOSE	0
SCORE 4 TRIES	1
LOSE BY 7 POINTS	1

If two teams have a similar record after group games then the order will be decided by:

- a) The team with the better points difference; or if equal
- b) The team having scored the most points; or if equal
- c) The result of the group game between the tied teams
- d) Team scoring most tries.
- e) The toss of a coin.

In the event of a draw at full time at the knock out stage, then play will continue until the next score. The teams will change after each 5 minute period until a score decides the match.

\*If the score remains level following two periods of extra time the tie will be decided on the basis of the teams' playing record so far in the Tournament and the above will apply.

## WEIGHT LIMIT

May I draw your attention to the weight limit in operation for our tournament; as with Rosslyn Park, we ask all teams to report to the control point to have their weight verified before playing their first game.

## FIRST AID

First Aid cover for our tournament is provided by the St. John's Ambulance Brigade. We would like to express our grateful thanks to the volunteers of this organisation on behalf of all those participating in the tournament.

## RUGBY SEVENS INFORMATION

1. It will help if teams arrive changed. However, shared changing facilities are available to sides.

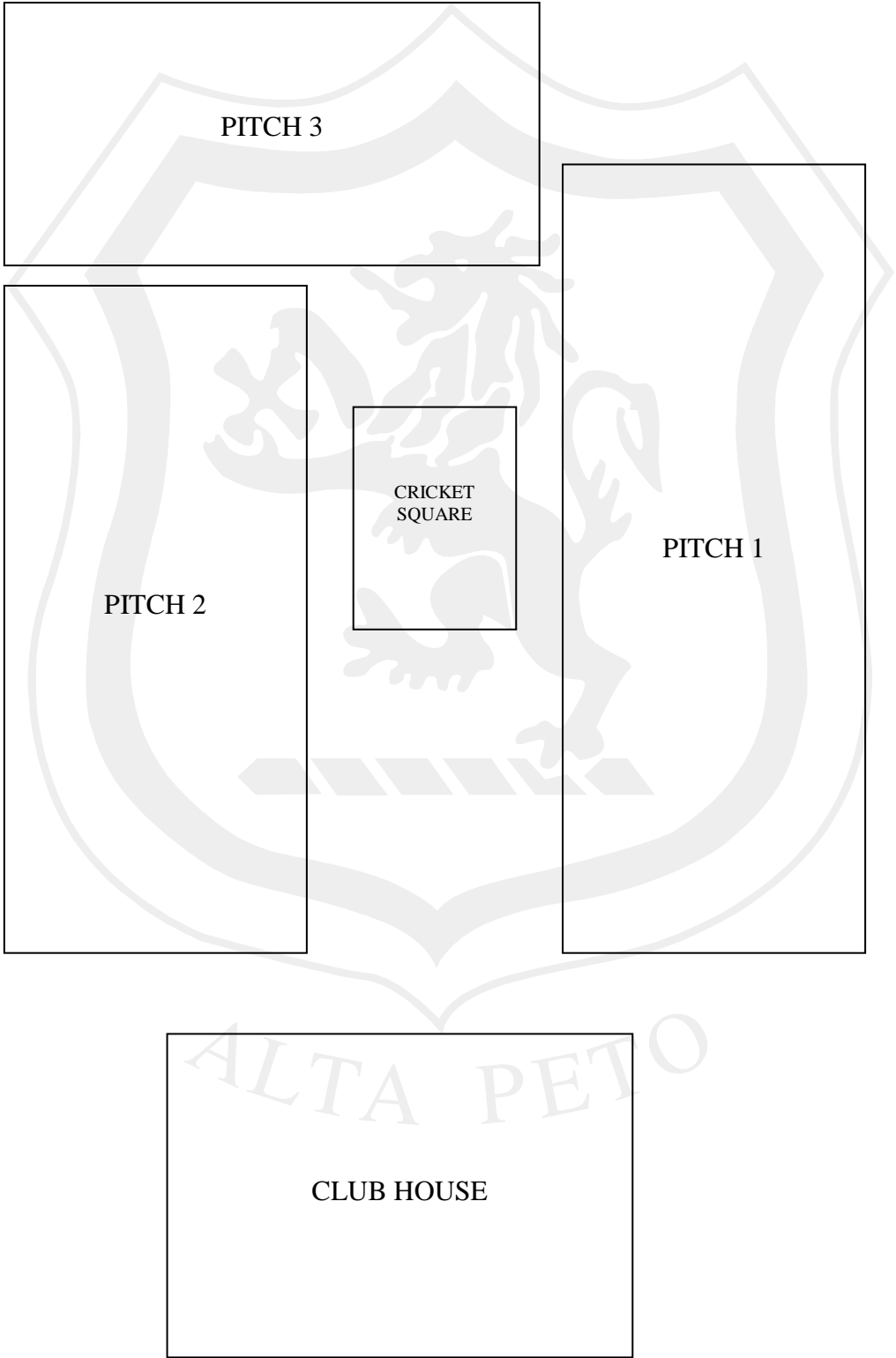

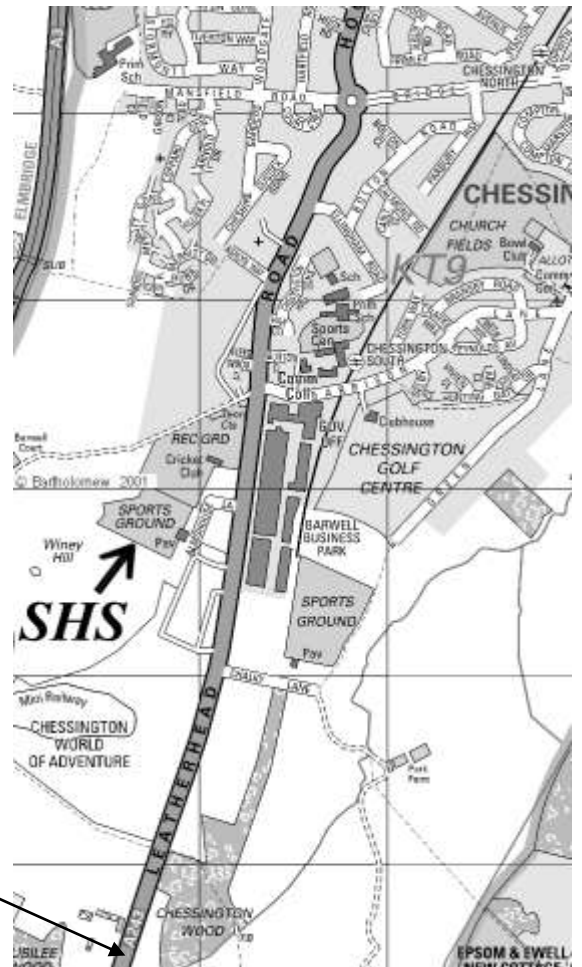
Pitch Layout
